Donate Devices

A powerful way to support charitable organisations while actively contributing to sustainability efforts and reducing e-waste. You can donate new or used devices in good working condition. We accept:

Laptops up to 5 years old

Tablets up to 7 years old

Phones up to 7 years old



Donate Data

People may be left behind simply because they do not have regular internet access. We provide dongles and sims to our recipients allowing them access to data and coverage.

Optus generously donate their services, if you are an Optus customer with an eligible mobile plan, you can donate a portion of data. Head online to find out how.



Donate Funds

Every \$240 results in one refurbished laptop, training and one year of internet access to a person in need. This is dramatically less than the average resale rate of a refurbished laptop and we need support to help cover the cost.

What happens to my donation?



Reclaim

Donate used laptops, phones or tablets in good working condition



Refurbish

Devices are tested, securely wiped and refurbished by accredited partners, ready for distribution.



Recycle

Any laptops that don't pass the test or are not fit for purpose, are responsibly recycled.



Rehome

Good360 distributes the devices at no cost where they are needed most via our trusted charity member network.

FAQs

What devices do you take?

We take new or used devices:

Laptops up to 5 years old

Tablets up to 7 years old

Phones up to 7 years old

Contact us if you are a manufacturer or supplier and have new accessories to give.

How many devices do you accept?

We take a minimum of 10 devices and have had several major technology firms give us more than 500 at a time. If you have larger volumes, please get in touch to discuss your needs.

Who does it go to?

Our vetted network of over 4,700 charities and disadvantaged schools are on a waitlist ready to receive devices and pass them on to the

members of their local community most in need.

They sign an agreement that they may not sell any of the received devices.

In some cases, where there is no funding to cover the cost of refurbishment, a very small amount may be sold to cover these costs.

How do I know my donation is handled securely?

Ensuring the security of sensitive information is essential. You may erase/reset your devices but we also wipe ALL donated devices as they may still contain personal data. By partnering with Good360, businesses can confidently donate their technology, knowing that we work with trusted partners who provide world-class data sanitisation services. This ensures compliance with data privacy regulations, minimises risks, and safeguards your organisation's reputation.

We keep a stock of mobiles and SIM cards on hand ready to give to our visitors who have fled domestic violence situations. They feel a sense of relief knowing their partners can no longer track them and that they still have a means to access support networks, manage their own finances, for work or apply for housing when they are ready to move on from crisis accommodation. We also have a laptop library to help with the transition - but the kids are loving them too, especially the 10 year old who had never before used technology.
